YOUTH SUMMER EXPERIENCE

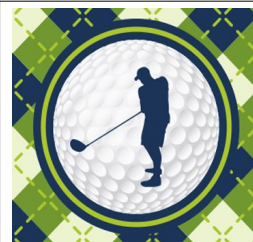

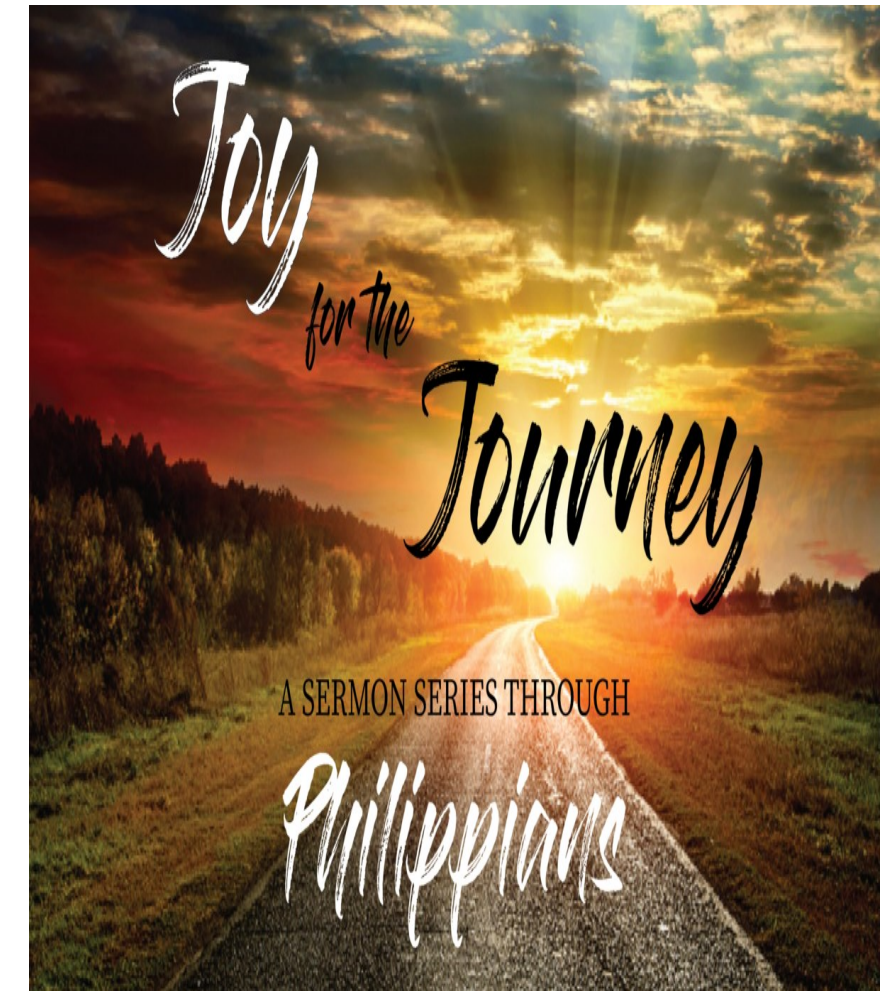

Philippians 1:27-30 NIV

Whatever happens, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ.
