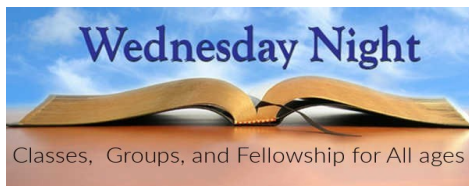
STEWARDSHIP COMMITMENT

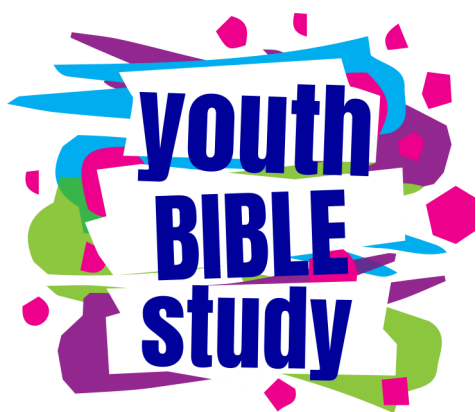
