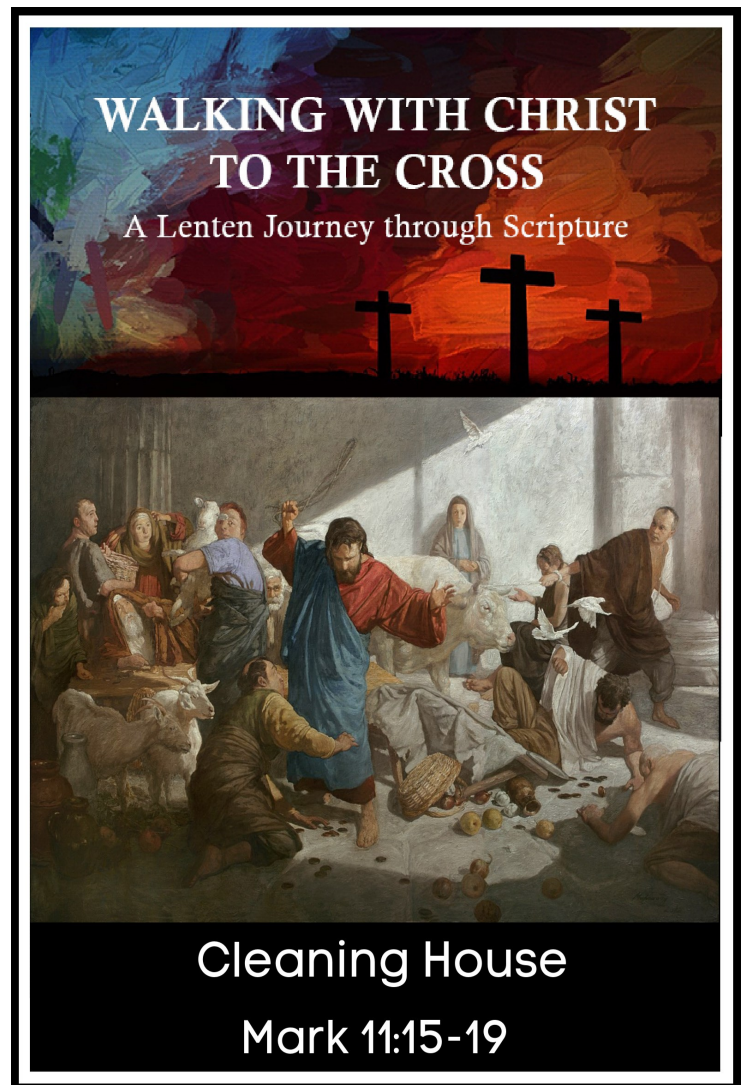

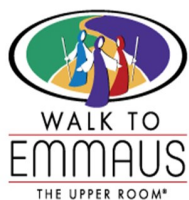

PALM SUNDAY - MARCH 24TH

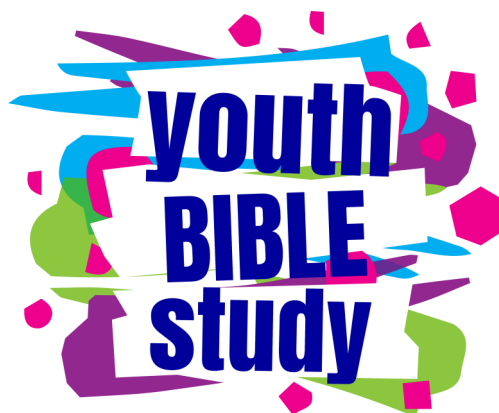
